CHOICE FOOD PANTRY

Dignifying experience

Unlike traditional food distribution models, Grace Care Center operates a choice-based system resembling a grocery store. This approach preserves dignity and empowers individuals to select items based on their dietary preferences and family needs.

Prioritizing nutrition

By prioritizing nutrition through a point system that encourages healthier choices, the Choice Food Pantry promotes balanced and wholesome selections, ensuring that families not only receive assistance but also have the opportunity to make healthier dietary choices.

Investing in impact

In 2023, Grace Care Center spent \$106,000 in food purchase to supplement donated items to ensure shelves were full. \$1,500,000 in food and items were distributed to Friends.

Every \$1 Grace Care Center spends on food returns \$14 to our Central Indiana community

MOBILE PANTRY

Care into the community

The Mobile Pantry by the Grace Care Center mobilizes the Grace Care Center's unique and dignifying model of choice into our central Indiana communities — especially those areas that don't have great access to wholesome food and are limited by some transportation barriers.

Emergency response

When a tornado hit Sullivan, Indiana in March 2023 and decimated their community and their area's food pantry, Grace Care Center swiftly mobilized resources to provide essential supplies and support. With its flexible operations, collaborative partnerships, and compassionate approach, the Mobile Pantry offers quality care when and where it's needed most.

REFERRAL SERVICES

Volunteer led

Volunteer advocates are mobilized and trained to offer personalized support across a spectrum of needs, including financial literacy, employment, legal matters, health, and housing.

Individualized support

By offering individualized support plans tailored to unique circumstances, the program empowers participants to navigate challenges and progress towards sustainability.


VEHICLE SERVICES

MICRO SAVINGS & LOAN

Preventing predatory loans

The Microfinance Savings & Loan program offers accessible capital and flexible repayment plans to those facing barriers to traditional financial services. The program features zero-interest rates, preventing borrowers from using high-interest predatory payday loans that perpetuate poverty.

Recycling philanthropy

Through the innovative Microfinance Savings & Loan program, Friends of the Grace Care Center repay the funds they borrow, which are then recycled to be lent out again multiple times, amplifying their impact.







WHAT'S AHEAD?

Grace Care Center programs are shaping a resilient and inclusive community in Central Indiana, empowering individuals and families to thrive. With your help, Grace Care Center aims to revolutionize infrastructure and mobilize services through efficiency, innovation, and outreach.

EFFICIENCY

To increase capacity to meet growing needs, Grace Care Center aims to optimize warehouse operations. This includes more efficient sorting and storage to double capacity and improve our response to community emergencies.

- Enhance food distribution efficiency and innovation through warehouse optimization.
- Serve more families with more food and goods.
- Grow capacity for emergency response.
- Multiply partnerships and inventory.



INNOVATION

Central Indiana has serious transportation limitations. The Grace Care Center will integrate its successful Microfinance Savings & Loan Program with options for purchasing vehicles. Expanding the availability of vehicle purchase options means more individuals can stay on the road.

- Expand the availability of vehicle purchase loans through promotion of vehicle donation.
- Provide flexible loan terms tailored to the financial circumstances of borrowers.
- Offer financial literacy education and budgeting support to borrowers.
- Monitor and provide ongoing support services to borrowers throughout the loan repayment period.



OUTREACH

Bringing care directly to those in need, Grace Care Center expands its services to underserved areas through Mobile Pantry outreach.

This creates space for partnering with other organizations to offer a wide range of services, enhancing impact and accessibility.

- Expand the Mobile Pantry serving locations in underserved areas.
- Partner with other Central Indiana services and organizations to establish a mobile hub of resources.
